Amir Dossal is a visionary leader and social entrepreneur advancing sustainable development through innovative, cross-sector partnerships. He is President & CEO of the Global Partnerships Forum, a global knowledge platform empowering change-makers to deliver impact aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

A pioneer in global collaboration, Mr. Dossal has co-founded several influential initiatives, including the Pearl Initiative, the Blockchain Commission for Sustainable Development, and the Global Mental Health Task Force. He is a founding Commissioner of the Broadband Commission for Sustainable Development, a Distinguished Fellow at the World Economic Forum's Centre for Health and Healthcare, Chairman of AQUAE Impact, and curator of Vision for the Future, a digital anthology featuring global leaders driving change.

A 25-year veteran of the United Nations, Mr. Dossal established the UN Fund for International Partnerships in 1998 to manage the historic \$1 billion gift from Ted Turner, and served as the founding Executive Director of the UN Office for Partnerships. During his tenure, he founded several new initiatives covering Peacekeeping, Peacebuilding, Management Reform and Partnerships.

A UK Chartered Accountant (FCA), Mr. Dossal is the recipient of numerous international honors, including the Ellis Island International Medal of Honor. He is married to Tas, they have one son, Zecki, who is a Senior Director at Henry Schein.
