David M. Hayes is President of the David Hayes Art Foundation, curating museum exhibitions of his father, acclaimed sculptor David Hayes.

Based in New York, he brings decades of experience in arts, publishing, and cultural programming. He also helms the Argian Press, a printer of fine art books, after heading his eponymous advertising agency in Miami, Florida for seventeen years where he served such clients as American Express, Sunbeam, Johnnie Walker, Mr. Coffee, and the French Consulate. Mr. Hayes is an international specialist, previously affiliated with the Ogilvy Group's Euramerica International. Previously, he was the Assistant to the Chairman at the Souham Communication Group of New York, Paris, and Geneva.

He is a graduate of Hamilton College and also studied at the Institut d'Études Politiques, the Institut Britannique and the Sorbonne in Paris, and the Parsons School in New York.

For his contributions to French-American cultural relations, Mr. Hayes was knighted on Bastille Day of 2006 when he was named a Chevalier de l'Ordre National du Mérite by decree of the President of France Jacques Chirac.
