Prince Dimitri of Yugoslavia (born June 18, 1958) is a prince of the former Yugoslav royal family and an internationally recognized jewelry designer. The eldest son of Prince Alexander of Yugoslavia and Princess Maria Pia of Savoy, he is the eldest grandson of King Umberto II of Italy.

Raised in Europe and educated in France where he got a law degree, Prince Dimitri began his career at Sotheby's in Geneva and New York, where he spent 17 years and became Senior Vice President in the jewelry department. He later founded his own fine jewelry brand, known for refined craftsmanship, historical inspiration, and elegant, timeless design.

He serves as Delegate in the United States for the Order of Saints Maurice and Lazarus and is active in philanthropic and cultural initiatives.
