Author, international speaker, and social architect, Gina was most recently the Senior Advisor to Pope Francis' Summit on Climate and the One Human Family.

Gina is the award-winning author of the #1 best-selling children's book, *Cassandra's Angel*, as well as the Founder and CEO of *Gina's Ink*, honored with the Media for Social Impact Award. This mission-driven media and entertainment social enterprise empowers children globally through social-emotional engagement, education, and gamified learning that inspires micro-actions on the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.

For twenty years, Gina has toured the world speaking to girls and women in war zones, child-soldier refugee camps, human trafficking shelters, orphanages, and girl's schools across Southeast Asia and Africa, using *Cassandra's Angel* as a vehicle to ignite the possibility of a brighter future without limitations. She has produced an ongoing Title I Schools tour visiting the most underserved children in the United States. Gina will be visiting Kyiv, Ukraine, in 2026 to work with children affected by the war.

For decades, Gina has actively shared her work at the highest levels of Hollywood, Silicon Valley, Wall Street, the United Nations, Washington, D.C., global governments, and even space through her role as Chief Purpose Officer and Producer of *Zero G Colony*, a multifaceted entertainment and environmental platform focused on the intersection of space, the environment, and innovation. She has been featured on dozens of news and television shows, including *Good Day New York* and *The Doctors*.

Gina is the Founder of *We the Peoples Fund*, focused on reforestation, ocean restoration, refugees, and international infrastructure. She is the former Global Chairman on Environment, Climate Action, Biodiversity, and Oceans for the Women's Economic Forum.

Gina was honored by Guggenheim Partners for Women's History Month and has been a featured speaker at the United Nations, Milken Institute Global Conference, the World Innovation Network, and to a 100,000+ person audience as the guest of the President of Taiwan. She recently received the Exceptional Woman of Excellence Award from the Women's Economic Forum.

Gina's career began in Hollywood, spanning 12 years in film and television at Lucasfilm, NBC, CBS, and Viacom. where she worked with the A-list of Hollywood for over a decade.
